

Dr. Steven Greenstein is the medical director at the Cornea and Laser Eye Institute and the CLEI center for Keratoconus. He is a graduate of Harvard Medical School's Cornea, Refractive, and External Disease fellowship at Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary. Prior to and during his professional ophthalmic career, Dr. Greenstein published a multitude of articles and wrote many book chapters on corneal crosslinking (CXL) for the treatment of keratoconus. He is a co-inventor of Corneal Tissue Addition Keratoplasty (CTAK), a novel surgical technique to treat Keratoconus.

Dr. Greenstein is board certified in Ophthalmology and is a board certified fellow in refractive surgery. He is a clinical associate professor at Rutgers – New Jersey Medical School. He is currently a member of the American Academy of Ophthalmology, American Society of Cataract and Refractive Surgeons, the Refractive Alliance, the Cornea Society, and the Society of Heed Fellows. Dr. Greenstein is also a team Ophthalmologist for the New York Jets Football team.
